APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

In order to register for the European Summer Program each participant must complete two (2) registration forms. The first is from Trinity Law School and the other from the International Institute of Human Rights in Strasbourg, France.

MANDATORY ITEMS THAT MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR SUBMISSION:

1. *European Summer Program Registration Form* from Trinity Law School and Trinity Graduate School
 - ❑ \$350 deposit
2. *Application For Admission* from the International Institute of Human Rights
 - ❑ Include a photocopy of your highest university diploma.
 - ❑ Include a short curriculum vitae, commonly referred to as CV. For our purposes simply provide a list of courses taken that are even relatively related to the area of human rights or why you want to attend. You may include philosophy, legal, political, etc. List any teaching and research experience, publications, honors, awards, or memberships are also welcome.
 - ❑ Include two passport photos [U.S. Post Office issued preferred. No cropped photos]

- Request approval for partial payment: Pay 50% prior due May 11, 2009, and final payment due 9/1/2009.

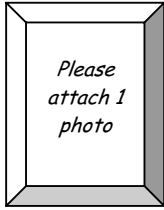
REFUND POLICY
